SJC GA West Renewal Badging Procedures

The process to renew a badge requires one appointment. You'll need a Non-SIDA Badge Testing appointment.

2. Select the "Appointments" tile.

2. Scroll down to find the "Non-SIDA Badge Testing" area and select "Schedule Appointment".
