

Southwest Airlines Restores Daily Service Between Mineta San José International Airport and Reno-Tahoe International Airport

Gateway to the Sierra Nevada and Lake Tahoe Area from Silicon Valley

San José, Calif. – Starting today, Southwest Airlines is relaunching its daily nonstop service between <u>Norman Y. Mineta San José International Airport (SJC)</u> and <u>Reno-Tahoe International Airport</u>. The daily flight departs San José at various times throughout the week aboard a Boeing 737 aircraft, arriving in Reno, Nevada in the morning to early afternoon timeframe.
